- 90001 BEGINNER (UP TO 2 MIN) For young composers who have a basic understanding of notation and harmony.
- 90002 INTERMEDIATE (UP TO 4 MIN) For composers who have a good understanding of diatonic harmony (I ii iii IV V vi viio), simple modulations, and have written a few works in the past.
- ADVANCED (UP TO 6 MIN) For composers with a good understanding of chromatic harmony (exsecondary dominants, augmented 6th chords, model mixture), extended chords (ex: V7(b9)), chromatic modulation, arranging and orchestration. Composers for this category will have written numerous works in the past for various instruments and ensembles.

No limit to genre (classical, jazz, atonal, film inspired, etc) or instrumentation (solo, chamber, orchestral).

- Participants may submit more than one work under the same group by entering the same group code.
